



Maulana Saiyed Abul Hasan Ali Hasni Nadwi (RA)

Maulana Saiyed Abul Hasan Nadwi was born in Takya Kalaa, Raye Bareli, UP, in a scholarly family on 24 November, 1914 and took his last breath in 1999.

He obtained higher education from Darul Uloom Nadwatul-Ulama and served in the same university as a professor and rector till the last minute of his life. He authored hundreds of books in Urdu and Arabic, “Maza khaseral A’alam be-in hetatil-muslimeen” in Arabic and “Insani dunya par musalmanon ka orooz wa zawal ka Asar” in Urdu, revived the faith in the hearts of the millions of Muslims and theses two masterpiece of works allotted him a huge reputation in Arab and Islamic worlds.

He was widely known as reformer and Islamic thinker and philosopher; he received a number of awards and honors inside and outside of the country.

He conferred Nadwatul-Ulama all round prosperity and development; from quality education and teachings to constructions, consequently, it had been taken as one of the most prominent institutions of the country. On the other hand, in his president ship “Muslim Personal Law Board” also received a huge acceptance by the masses, subsequently; it turned into a trustful and united platform for Indian Muslims.
