



## **Maulana Saiyed Minnatullah Rahmani (Rh)**

Maulana Saiyed Minnatullah Rahmani was born on 7<sup>th</sup> April 1913 in the house of a well-known Islamic scholar, reformer and Sufi, Maulana Muhammad Ali Mungeri and passed away in 19<sup>th</sup> March 1991.

He made educational journey to Hyderabad, then moved to Darul Uloom Nadwatul Ulama Lacknow and finally he completed his master degree (Fazilat) from Darul Uloom Deoband. Maulana Husain Ahmad Madani (Rh), Maulana Asgar Husain Deobandi (Rh), Maulana Mufti Muhammad Shafee Deobandi (Rh) and Allama Ibraheem Balyawi (Rh) were among his prominent teachers.

He was only as an ordinary scholar, rather a daring and courageous Islamic scholar, socio-religious activist and leader, well-experienced politician and spiritual reformer. In one hand, he carried forward Jamia Rahmani Munger to being a Jamia and lead this institution to its current heights to impart learners Islamic Education, and Khanqah Rahmani to cultivate the hearts with spiritual power, on the other hand, served the community and Ummah in social, welfare and legal aspects from the platform of Imarat-e-Shariyeh and All India Muslim Personal Law Board.

After the consultation with Islamic scholars he established “All India Muslim Person Law Board” to unite Indian Muslims on one platform and lit a ray of hope and sprite to survive here being a true follower of Islam.
