



Maulana Rizwan Al-Qasmi (rh)

Maulana was born on 11 July 1944 at Darbhanga district, Bihar and left this ephemeral world for his eternal abode on 11th October 2004.

He received his early education at Jami'a Rahmania, Munger (Bihar); Madrasah Dhakah, Champaran (Bihar) and Madrasah Husainiah, Ranchi (Jharkhand). For intermediate and higher studies he joined Darul Uloom Deoband, UP, he also enrolled in Qur'an specialization course here.

In the advice of Qari Muhammad Tayyib (Rh), visited Hyderabad and was appointed as Imam and Khateeb (speaker) of Masjid-e Amera.

He founded Darool Uloom Sabilus Salam in 1972 and by day night struggles and tireless efforts lead this institution to its pick.

Writings:

Being an exemplary orator, public speaker, teacher and administrator, he was also a peerless writer and literary figure. His favorite poet was Khumar, Maulana penned a number of books, some of which are listed here below:

Relation with Academy:

Maulana had close relation with Qazi Mujahidul Islam Qasmi, that was the reason that he was very close to Academy from the very first day of its existence and worked there as its founding member.

After the death of Hazrat Qazi Mujahidul Islam Qasmi (Rh) new elected comity unanimously appointed him its vice-presidents and hold this office till the last breath of life.
