



Maulana Zubair Ahmad Qasmi (rh)

Maulana Zubair Ahmad Qasmi was born in the house of late Abdush Shakur in Chndarsainpur of district Madhubani in Bihar on 1st January 1936 and passed away on 13 January 2019 at 06:30 am.

Primary Education:

He obtained primary and secondary level education at Madrasa Basharatul Uloom, Darbhanga, here Maulana Sayeed Aham (Rh) was his beloved teacher.

Higher studies:

He joined Darul Uloom Deoband in the year 1377, and completed his Fazilat in Islamic Studies in 1379. Here he learnt from the qualified Islamic scholars: Maulana Fakhruddin (Rh), Maulana Ibrahim Baliawi (Rh) and Maulana Fakhru Hasan.

Teaching career:

After completing his academic studies from Darul Uloom Deoband, he was appointed as a teacher at Madrasa Basharatul Uloom, district Darbhanga. After a couple of years, he joined Jamia Ashraf-ul-Uloom, Kanahwan, Sitamarhi (Bihar), and rendered splendid services for 14 years tirelessly teaching primary and secondary standard books. Later on he worked for one year at Jamia Qasmi, Gaya, in 1398 he moved to Jamia Rahmani, Munger and kept teaching primary and secondary level books till 1406. He also remained in Jamia Miftahul Uloom, Mau, for one year as professor of Hadith. Finally, in the request of Maulana Rizwan Al-Qasmi he joined Darul Uloom Sabilus Salam, Hyderabad, as Sheikhul Hadeeth. Again in 1412 A.H. he moved back to Jamia Ashraf-ul-Uloom, Kanahwan and performed his vigorous services as rector till his death.

He was founding member of the Academy from the very first day of its establishment and attended its all the symposiums and meetings regularly.
